WARNER, THOMAS DICKENS JR, '44

23 March 2012, at Portsmouth Maryview Hospital, 86.

Joined the Marines when he graduated from AMA and served as Captain's orderly on the *USS Missouri*. Fought at Iwo Jima with Task Force 58 and was 20mm gunner on the starboard side in the Battle of Okinawa when a kamikaze hit the port side.

Volunteered for 6th Marines and fought on Okinawa. Participated in the Japanese surrender in the area of Tsingtao, China. Retired after 25 years of Federal service.

Survived by his daughter, Elizabeth Warner Respass; a son, Thomas; three grandchildren; four great-grandchildren; and his sister, Elizabeth Warner Coffey.

At Augusta four years: D Company; intramurals, varsity boxing team.
