WELLER, MARVIN R. '38

Flight Captain Weller was killed in California on 22 November 1944 while test piloting a B-24J "Liberator" which was being adapted for Navy use. He was a test pilot and flight instructor for Consolidated Vultee Aircraft Corporation, San Diego, employed in testing and ferrying various Navy and Army aircraft.

He was previously employed at Ryan School of Aeronautics, San Diego, an Army Air Corps primary training school, and had also flown for Georgia Aero Tech, Augusta, Georgia, at the Army Air Corps basic training school there. He had also served as a flight instructor at Randolph Field, TX. Interred in Thornrose Cemetery, Staunton, VA, near his home town of Verona.
