Died August 1986, in Windsor, NC. No further details are available.

After graduating from AMA, he graduated from the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill in 1933, receiving a B.A. degree in Chemistry.

During his freshman year at Carolina, he signed a contract to play professional baseball with the St. Louis Cardinals. He played professional baseball for ten years. Because of a knee injury he left baseball in 1940 and moved to Newport News, Virginia to work at the Newport News Ship Building and Dry Dock Company, where he was a supervisor.

In 1952 he moved to Windsor, North Carolina and entered into a partnership in the feed mill and livestock business with his two brothers. After 20 years in that business, he became a concrete product plant manager both in Windsor and Plymouth, North Carolina, where he worked until his retirement in 1981.
