WILSON, RICHARD P. '35

Died 21 September 2004, after a short illness.

From 1947 until 1983, he reorganized and operated Wilson and Stokes Company in Trenton, NJ, dealing in retail lumber, fuel oil, masonry supplies, coal and oxygen and acetylene gases. He had homes in Pisgah Forest, NC and Crystal Beach, FL.

A graduate of the Wharton School of Finance and the University of Pennsylvania, he was commissioned a Regular Army 2d lieutenant in 1939 and finished the war as a Lieutenant Colonel. After World War II, he stayed in the Air Force reserves, retiring at the rank of lieutenant colonel in 1947.

Survived by his wife of 62 years, Margaret MacLean; children, Sherry Sultenfuss and Gail Murray; and four grandchildren.
