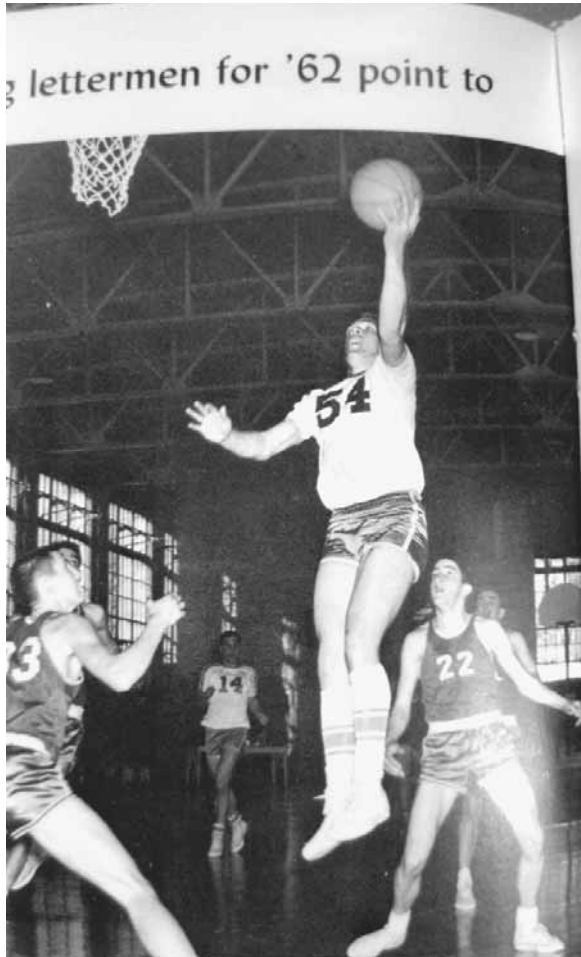




Three sport man Wayne Blaylock, '62

Wayne Blaylock played three sports at Augusta and was top notch in each: football, basketball and track.

With all these athletic activities, Wayne was still able to do a bangup job as the Captain of Headquarters Company. He was a Student Body officer, a member of the Honor Committee and the Cotillion Club, marched in the Roller Rifles and was elected to *Ad Astra*.

The 1961-62 Blaylock led football team won their final five games by a combined score of 168 to 14! Wayne was the Military Prep School All American running back that year and won a scholarship to Auburn.

On the basketball court, he scored 259 points his senior year and led AMA into the Military League Tournament. No Augusta cadet other than Wayne was ever named to the National High School All America Basketball Team.

On the track, Blaylock set a 21'2" broad-jump record. The track team had a winless season in 1961-62 but Wayne Blaylock starred in every meet.
