

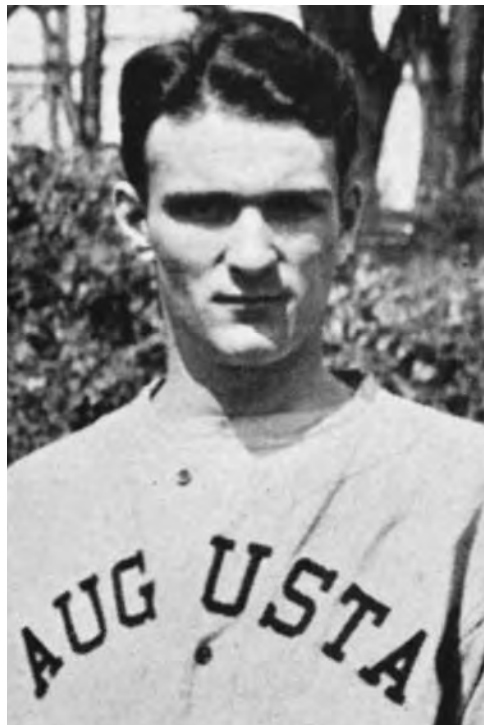


## Earl Cabaniss, '43, earned eleven letters in four sports
