



DOUG CARTER, '72, played basketball and football at AMA. Before he came to Augusta... he had graduated from Robert E. Lee High School in Staunton.

Doug's high school football coach... Dave Holtsclaw... came to coach at AMA... and Doug came with him in the Fall of 1971. His defensive play on our team caught the eye of none other than Lou Holtz... then the head football coach at North Carolina State.

Doug played defensive tackle for the Wolfpack for four years... and his defensive coach was Al Michaels.

NC State beat West Virginia 49-13 in the 1972 Peach Bowl... played Kansas in the Liberty Bowl the next year winning 31-18... played Houston to a 31-31 tie in 1974 in the Bluebonnet Bowl... and the Mountaineers got their revenge in the 1975 Peach Bowl edging State 13-10.

Doug was an outstanding defensive star in all four bowl games.

In 1976... he received a BA in history and returned to Lee in 1976 where he taught history... geography and social studies for 30 years.



At the same time... he coached the football team... ending with a 24-24-2 record... and in his 30 years also coached at various times wrestling... baseball... and track... even officiating at football... basketball and track meets.
