

Ken Hoke, '54, Ray Marcantoni, '70, and 1951 basketball team enter AMA Sports Hall of Fame

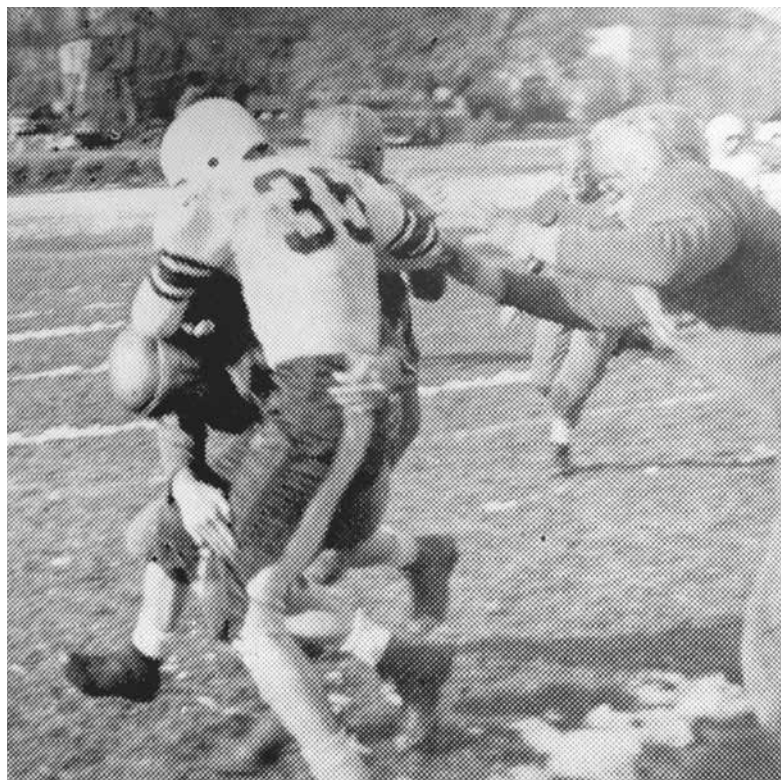
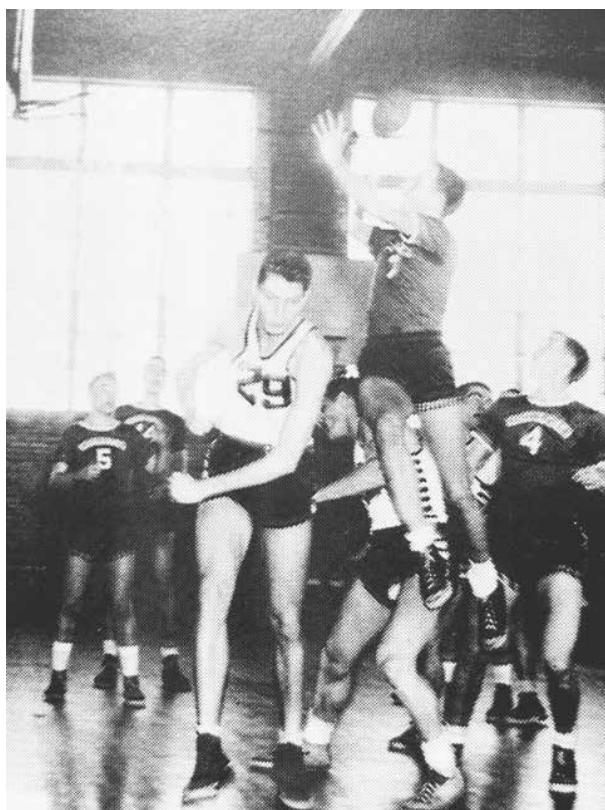
Two stud athletes and an entire basketball team were inducted into the AMA Sports Hall of Fame during Reunion 2014.

Ken Hoke, '54, was the quarterback of the 1953-54 football team in the year after AMA de-emphasized football with no more players headed for college doing one PG year at Augusta. The team still played the big boys and Ken excelled though the team had a losing record.

Ray Marcantoni, '70, was the captain of every team he played on including JV and varsity football, lacrosse and wrestling. He lettered in wrestling for six of the seven years he was at Augusta, in lacrosse for four years and in wrestling for three often being All Military.

The **1950-51 varsity basketball team**, coached by **Jerry Claiborne**, won the Military School Championship and went to the Eastern Tournament in Glenn Falls, NY where they took five of the seven major trophies awarded. The Blue Streaks were undefeated except for a single loss to the UVA freshman team.

The new Hall of Famers were inducted by **Frank Williamson, '60**, at the Saturday reunion luncheon .
