George Richardson, '64

George Richardson, '64, attended AMA for two years (1962-1964), being from Newport News, Virginia.

He was a very talented all-around athlete, participating on the football, swimming, baseball and track teams, lettering in all four sports!

He was the fastest guy on the football team, going both ways in several position – the “utility man”. And he was recognized as one of the best punters in the Military School League!

George was the #1 diver on the Swim Team.

In the spring, he double-timed back and forth between the baseball field and the track where he was the best sprinter in the 100 yd dash, threw the shot-put, and started in center-field.

George was a truly special and gifted athlete!

George was also on the Roller Rifles, his senior year.
