



Douglas W. Pennock was born in San Juan Puerto Rico and currently resides in San Juan. He was enrolled into AMA in the Fall of 1966 and graduated six (6) years later in June of 1972. Doug played some soccer for Col. Hoover, fenced for Col. Hoover, played JV Lacrosse for Col. Hoover, and played Varsity Lacrosse for Major “Big Ed” Hart. He graduated from AMA holding the rank of Cadet Major and was the Battalion XO, Commander of the Roller Rifles, and was a member of the Honor Committee.

After graduation, Doug attended College at Miami Dade Collage in Miami, Fla where he studied Business Administration. Doug minored in Criminology, but his father was not keen on getting into Law Enforcement so that never panned out.

After college, Doug was married to his wife of (now) 47 years, Trudy Dallmayr and moved back to Puerto Rico in early 1977. He worked in the family Nursery business for nine years. He was offered the position of President of a publicly traded nursery operation “Margo Farms del Caribe” in 1988. And after an 11-year stint with Margo Farms, Doug started his own company in 1999 (Pennock Growers, Inc.). This has expanded with two additional companies: Pennock Landscaping LLC and recently acquired BrightView Puerto Rico LLC (September of 2020), making them now the largest landscape maintenance company in Puerto Rico. Doug retired in April of 2022, but that did not last long. In November of 2023, Doug started DWP Associates LLC.

Doug has always been an active alumnus by attending many AMA Alumni Reunions over the past 49 years. And he also keeps in close touch with many of his AMA brothers. Doug was the Commander of the Roller Rifles II for three of their four reunion performances. And he is a recipient of the AMA Alumni Medal.

In 2018, Doug volunteered and was elected to the AMA Alumni Foundation Board. He served as Vice-Chairman from 2018 to 2020 and was elected Chairman in April of 2020, a position he holds today.
